

## Adult French classes

We provide classes for adults of all levels: from complete beginners who wish to learn French to use on their holiday, improvers who would like to get back to French and improve their skills, to intermediate who would like to brush up their French, practise and learn even more!

## Beginners (A1.1)

A complete introduction to the French language for students who have no knowledge of French at all.

## Improvers (A1.2)

For those who:

- have completed the beginners course
- have a very basic knowledge of French
- are going back to study French after
a number of years


## Intermediate (A2-B1)

For those with a good basic knowledge of the language who wish to improve their communication skills and become more fluent in the language.

We provide classes for teenagers from 1st year to 6th year, including preparation for Junior and Leaving Cert.

For the preparation to the exams, we will work on both oral and written skills, complementing their schoolwork preparation.

We will focus on the main main elements of the written paper, helping students to develop their listening and reading comprehension skills.

We will also focus on the oral exam and build their confidence and fluency in the different topics they are likely to encounter.

The course includes a one-to-one mock oral exam.
The maximum number of students per class is 8 . This allows each student to get individual attention and classes tailored to their needs. They will also feel more confident to speak French and ask any questions they could have.

We offer French classes for children aged from 4 to 11 years-old, with no or very little knowledge of French.

French will be introduced through varied and stimulating activities, such as songs, art and crafts, role-plays, mimes, board games, or even baking!

While vocabulary is important, we also aim to give children the communicative skils that will enable them to express themselves in French.

The maximum number of children per class is 8 , which allows each child to receive plenty of personal attention.
